## Pastoral Reflection

### Leadership in Pressure Situations

The silence fell over the hall like a sheet used to cover a corpse. The sound system had failed and everyone - from the principal to the teachers to the students - stood looking around, as if the turning from left to right would somehow repair the equipment. The murmuring began, followed by some giggling, and it would have given rise to full-blown cacophony if nothing was done.

At that moment, a portly, stout figure dashed onto the stage, grabbed the microphone and started singing the National Anthem ... acapella. After the first two lines, the teachers started joining in and then the students followed suit. Soon enough, the entire school body was singing acapella.

The hero of the moment was the vice-principal. Down-to-earth, unassuming, unashamedly genuine, he was not the most impressive or eye-catching of individuals, but he was definitely well-respected, selflessly dedicated and much-loved, a true leader in every sense of the word. He could be counted on even in high-pressure circumstances, and that morning proved it.

Of course, Joshua and the leaders of Israel faced a far more stressful situation when the Gibeonite party came to them to seek a peace treaty. The stakes were higher and the decision made would have far-reaching ramifications.

While decisions like choosing to lead the school in the singing of the National Anthem may seem inconsequential in the larger scheme of things, what Joshua had to decide to do was not. Yet, it was stated clearly in the passage that he did not seek God and His guidance, despite finding himself in such a predicament.

The lesson to learn, then, is that godly leadership is not about character, courage or conviction, like what my vice-principal showed. Rather, it is defined by seeking God in all decisions, especially in situations when the time and space to deliberate before acting is absent. In fact, the Bible makes it clear that God welcomes all believers to turn to Him for guidance and will give it in abundance when we seek Him. After all, James 1:5 tells us, "If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you."

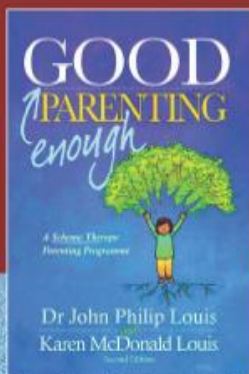
