Pastoral Reflection

Seeking GOD Together

Beginning on 1 July, our church will join hundreds of thousands of believers and hundreds of churches across Singapore in a united 40 Days of Prayer and Fasting, culminating on National Day, 9 August. This year's emphasis is simple yet powerful: TOGETHER.

The Christian life was never meant to be lived alone. From the earliest days of the Church, God's people gathered together to pray, worship, and seek His face. When believers unite in prayer, there is a special expression of our oneness in Christ and a powerful testimony that God's kingdom is greater than any individual church or denomination.

For these 40 days, we have the privilege of joining Christians throughout Singapore in seeking God's blessing upon our nation. While we worship in different congregations and traditions, we are one Body under one Lord. Together, we will lift our voices in thanksgiving for God's faithfulness to Singapore, intercede for our leaders, pray for our families and communities, and ask God for spiritual renewal across our land.

This season of prayer is especially significant as we approach National Day. As citizens and permanent residents of Singapore and followers of Christ, we recognize that our nation needs more than economic success or technological advancement. We need God's wisdom, God's righteousness, God's peace, and God's mercy. We need a fresh work of His Spirit in our churches and in our society.

One of the highlights of this prayer journey will be *Day of His Power* on 7 August, when we will join churches from across the eastern region of Singapore to pray together for our nation. What a wonderful opportunity to stand shoulder to shoulder with fellow believers, declaring our dependence upon God and our hope in Him. In a world often marked by division, the united prayers of God's people bear witness to the unity that Christ has given us.

I want to encourage you to participate wholeheartedly in these 40 days. Whether you choose to fast from meals, social media, entertainment, or other activities, let your fasting create space for deeper prayer. More importantly, remember that you are not praying alone. Every day, believers across Singapore will be seeking God together.

Imagine the impact when hundreds of thousands of Christians unite in prayer for revival, for the salvation of souls, for strong families, for godly leadership, and for God's blessing upon our nation. The Lord delights when His people come together in humility and faith.

Let us embrace this opportunity to seek God together, believe together, and stand together for Singapore. May these 40 days strengthen our unity, deepen our faith, and draw us closer to the heart of God.

National Council of Churches' Statement on the Staging of Jesus Christ Superstar in Singapore

The National Council of Churches of Singapore (NCCS) is aware of the discussions among Christians regarding the staging of the musical *Jesus Christ Superstar* in Singapore.

Jesus Christ Superstar is a rock opera created by Andrew Lloyd Webber and Tim Rice in the 1970s. It is an artistic interpretation of the final week of Jesus' life, primarily through the eyes of Judas Iscariot. It portrays Jesus as a conflicted prophet or revolutionary plagued by doubt as he approaches his death. It features Jesus' humanity but downplays his divinity. It depicts Jesus' crucifixion but is completely silent about the resurrection.

Christians have diverse views about *Jesus Christ Superstar*. Some Christians regard its portrayal of Jesus as not only incomplete but also theologically problematic. Others have even taken offense because, in their view, the musical has blasphemously distorted the true identity of Jesus Christ. However, there are still others who view the musical as an artistic work that provides opportunities for reflection, conversation, and even witness concerning the person and work of Christ.

The NCCS acknowledges the different perspectives that Christians have on the musical, especially those with strong concerns. The Council has brought these legitimate apprehensions to the attention of the relevant authorities.

At this point, the Council wishes to affirm several important tenets of the Christian faith regarding the person of Jesus Christ. Christianity confesses that Jesus Christ is the incarnate Son of God, who died for the sins of the world and rose bodily from the dead on the third day. According to the Christian faith, Jesus Christ cannot be reduced to a mere prophet or teacher, much less a tragic figure of history. Artistic representations of Jesus should be judged on the basis of the biblical revelation and the faith of the Church through the ages. In this regard, the Jesus that the musical portrays does not fall within the bounds of Christian orthodoxy. In fact, in the history of Christianity, similar denials of the divinity of Christ – presenting him as only a human being, such as Ebionism – have been condemned as heresies.

With regard to this musical, the Council encourages Christians to express their convictions responsibly. It also urges believers to engage cultural works with discernment and wisdom.

For those who find the musical deeply offensive to their conscience or harmful to their faith, the Council respects their decision to abstain from viewing or supporting it. For those who choose to attend or reflect on the musical, the Council encourages a critical and prayerful engagement.

In a multi-religious society like Singapore, Christians are called to be true to the 'faith which was once for all delivered to the saints' (Jude 1:3) and to engage the wider culture with grace and respect.

Our purpose as salt and light of the world is best fulfilled when we bear witness to the truth of the Gospel in humility and love (Matthew 5:13-16). In this way, we offer a compelling account of our hope in Christ (1 Peter 3:15-16).
