Pastoral Reflection

COME TOGETHER TO PRAY FOR OUR NATION

*"If My people, who are called by My name,
will humble themselves and pray
and seek My face and turn from their wicked ways,
then I will hear from heaven and
will forgive their sins and will heal their land."*

— 2 Chronicles 7:14

Our nation Singapore celebrates another year of God's faithfulness, and as a church, one of the greatest gifts we can offer our nation is not merely our service but our prayers. Throughout Scripture, God works powerfully through His praying people. History repeatedly reminds us that whenever God's people humble themselves and seek Him together, He hears, He answers, and He moves in remarkable ways.

That is why I would like to warmly invite every member of our church family to join us at our monthly GAP (God Answers Prayer) meeting this coming Friday as we come together to pray for Singapore. Prayer is never our last resort — it is our first response.
