Pastoral Reflection

Is that you, God? (Following God's lead)

As a young Christian, I was taught to read my Bible and obey God's commands. As I got older, I was taught to "do God's will". Following His commands like a rule book was clear enough, but how do I discern what He wants me to do? It's not like I can hear His voice. . . or can I?

I was taught there were 5 pointers – Prayer, His Word, Godly counsel, Circumstances and Peace. At least that was the theory! As I continued in my faith-journey, I began to understand that God wants a relationship with me. It's not primarily about the "do"s and "don't"s, but a daily trusting and walking with Him. Following His lead, where He goes is where I should go.

To flesh this out, I'll share how I left BSF to serve as a church staff (this process took about a year):

I was serving in the church youth/youth adults ministries. I was also leading a class in BSF Singapore then. What more could God want of me?

Early 2011, two church elders sat me down and asked me to step up my commitment to church. I was reluctant. I enjoyed what I was already doing.

In March, Elder/Senior Pastor Francis was called home to the Lord. That triggered a disquiet in my spirit. I prayed: "Lord, if you desire me to serve in church, let it be that the Church Leadership approach me." Shortly after, they did.

As I did my preparation for BSF's Isaiah study, these verses leapt out at me:

Isaiah 52:12 "But you will not leave in haste or go in flight; for the LORD will go before you, the God of Israel will be your rear guard."

Isaiah 42:8-9

*See, the former things have taken place,
and new things I declare;
before they spring into being I announce them to you."*

Isaiah 42:16-17

*I will lead the blind by ways they have not known,
along unfamiliar paths I will guide them...*

Isaiah 43:18,19

*"Forget the former things; do not dwell on the past.
See, I am doing a new thing!*

I struggled, because while I was ok to leave later (not in haste!), I was not ready to leave BSF at the end of 2011. So, I bargained with God. Two conditions I laid

1. "I can't leave my class in a lurch, I need to stay a little while more." God's answer: My 2IC who was intended to be sent to lead another class, felt God told her to stay in this class! (She was unaware of my struggle.)

2. I really wanted to teach the books of Minor Prophets (scheduled for 2013). I asked God to let me stay 2 more years then I will leave. God's answer: New came from BSF HQ that Minor Prophets was completely removed from the BSF curriculum for revamping!!

God has spoken. There was nothing left to do but to tender my BSF resignation.

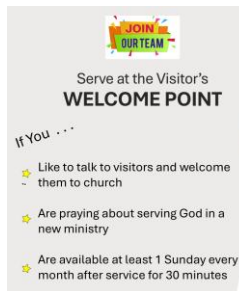
