Pastoral Reflection

Declaring His Works to the next generation (Psalm 145:1-13)

Ever since I have my kids, I have always asked myself what would I want to leave for them and how I would like them to remember me by. I am convinced that a spiritual legacy is what I would like to leave them with and I would like them to remember me as a faithful Christ's follower and servant.

With this aim in mind, I set out to ensure they are grounded in God's Word, growing spiritually, growing deeper in their faith so that when life's storms hit them, they can cling on to God. I had daily devotion and prayers with them when they were young before tucking them in bed. I prayed and believed a strong and firm foundation will hold them in good stead as they face the world's challenges and battles. I cannot be there for them, but I know my God can. We prayed for little things and everything and gave thanks for every answered prayer, teaching them to look to God, focus on God and give thanks in all things.

I shared about God's goodness and His work in my life at every opportunity and encourage them to do so too. Giving thanks and praising God at every juncture have also impacted my kids in a positive way.

Sunday services are not to be missed unless one is sick. When my kids were having examinations, Sunday services were still given priority. Worshipping and praising God in His house with fellow worshippers is not to be sidelined just because of examinations.

I am convinced that one's Christian walk and journey can be a good living testimony to our children and people around us if we live well and serve well. This also opens doors to share about Jesus when people ask questions about our faith and our life.

Steve Green's song "Find us faithful" is one of my favourites. It resonates with me and I pray that I will be able to live out the lyrics of the song well in my Christian walk and journey.

I like especially the lyrics of the song as they speak to me: -

And our children sift through all we've left behind
May the clues that they discover and the memories they uncover
Become the light that leads them to the road we each must find**
